Need to leave camp?

Any time you arrive or leave camp, even if it is just to make a coffee run or grab something from the store nearby, please be sure to **stop at the Admin Building or Dining Hall**. It is important for the safety of all of Camp for us to know who is here and not here. **There will be someone in the Office or Dining Hall from 7am-9pm.**

Parking Procedures:

While you can drive your car to your campsite, please be sure to **park it for the duration of your stay in the parking lot.**

Emergency Procedures:

In the event of an emergency, a siren will sound throughout camp, and the camp will **gather at the parade field** as quickly and safely as possible. If it's a **weather related emergency**, the camp will **gather in the Dining Hall**. Regardless, the staff will be in constant communication and will direct you to the safest place for you at that moment.

Friendly Reminders:

It is important to **wear the wristband** given to you at check-in during your **entire stay at camp** as it lets the staff know who has checked in and is supposed to be here at camp. Unless otherwise directed, **camp still runs as scheduled in the rain "liquid sunshine"**. Enjoy it! The staff will direct you to proper shelter if it is decided that there is more than lovely liquid sunshine. Lastly, please be sure to **wear plenty of sunscreen and bug spray, and drink lots of water. There will be ways to fill water bottles all across camp.** Need help finding the nearest clean water source? Ask a staff member and they will direct you!

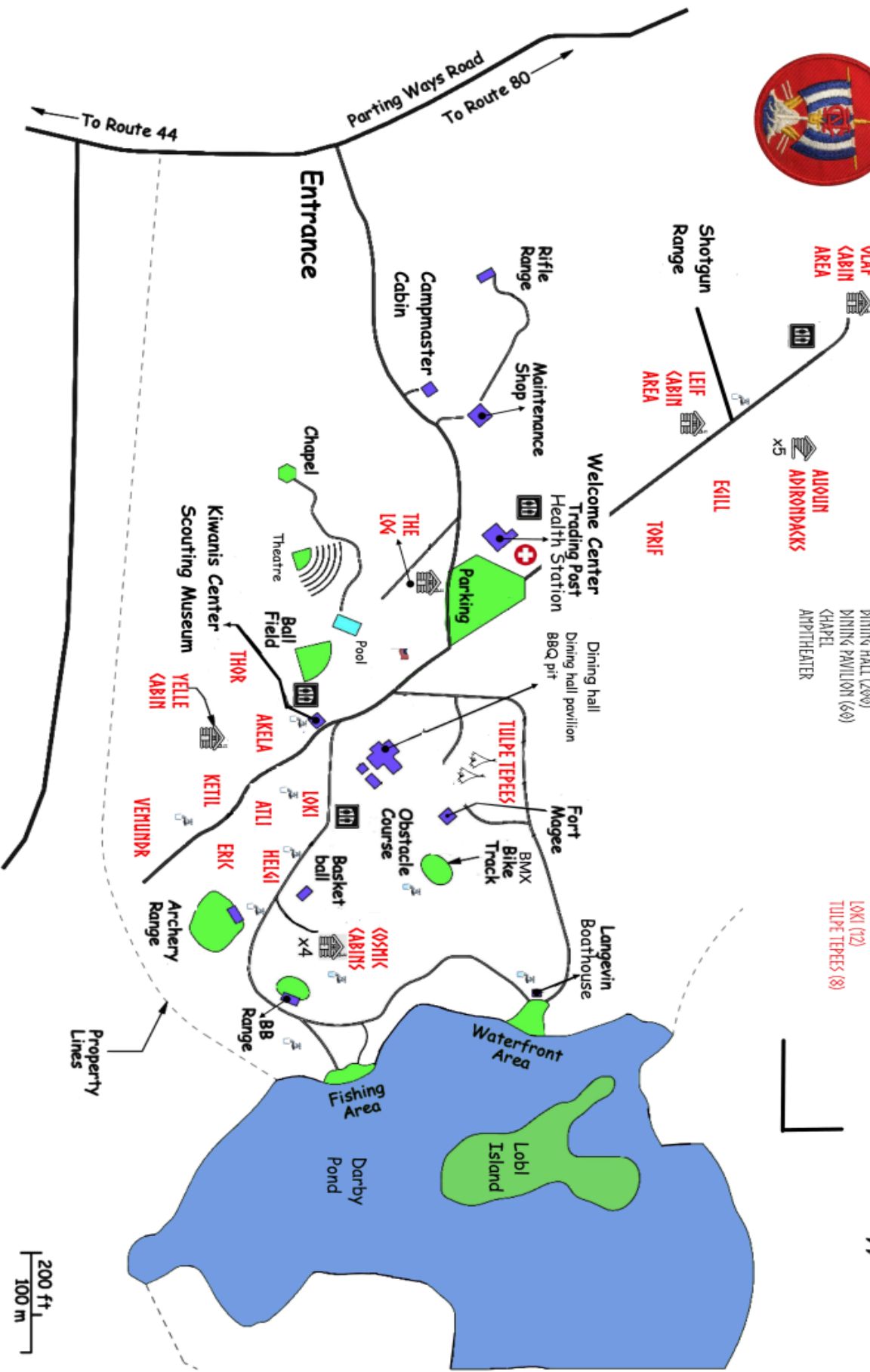
